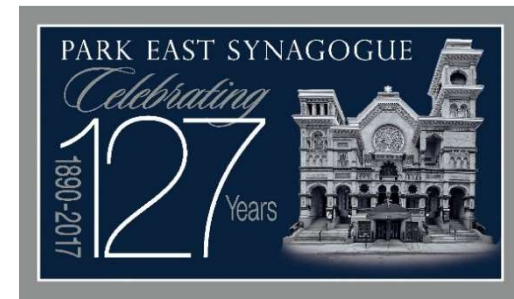
Curse me this people, for he is mightier than me (22:6)
