#### **PARSHAT VAYEISHEV**

They hated him and could not speak to him peacefully (Gen. 37:4)

In Leviticus, the Torah warns us, "You shall not hate your brother in your heart: You must rebuke your fellow." Rabbi Jonathan Eybschutz (Prague, 1695-1764), makes a psychologically trenchant point. When one person harbors ill will toward his fellow and remains silent about it, the bad feelings tend to amass and fester. Conversely, expressing those feelings can lead to conversation and understanding between the two parties. Thus we are told not to hate others "in our hearts" i.e. internally, but rather to speak with the person toward whom we have those feelings. Ultimately this might lead to a mutually agreeable resolution. Joseph's brothers resented him for being the favorite son, but they did not want to confront their father about this. Had they but told Joseph the reason for their animosity, a painful episode in the life of Jacob could have been avoided.
