Also facing the Taliban rule of Afghanistan emboldening Jihad terrorism that has claimed the lives of 13 U.S. troops and over 170 Afghans. We Jews, members of the human family are impacted by what is happening in the world, with the added burden of the ancient hatred of anti-Semitism particularly widespread at times of societal upheaval.
